- ATTENTION ALL BAKERS -

It's time to start thinking about what you might be able to bake for the cake stall for the St John's Parish Fete.

The cake stall relies on school and parish families to bake as many cakes, slices or biscuits as possible to make this stall a great success.

All families at St James, St Johns and the parish are being provided with food ingredient labels and instructions (via hard copy or email for school families) for their cake stall donations. We have not supplied plates and bags this year in an attempt to reduce landfill. Historically only 25% of plates are returned, which has resulted in unnecessary waste. If you are unable to supply your own plate please let us know and we can arrange something for you.

We encourage all families to make a donation no matter how big or small as every item counts.

Labelling

All items baked need to be labelled with your name, the date on which it was baked, whether it is fresh or frozen, and a list of all ingredients. **Remember, no cream please.**

If you prepare the product yourself, you will know what is in it. If you have used a packet mix write the ingredients from the packet on your label. Remember to include any other ingredients you may have added, such as eggs. A label template has been provided below. If packaging items for individual sale, please make sure each individual item is clearly labelled.

Foods or ingredients that are known to cause allergic reactions

If any of the food you are preparing for the fete contains any ingredient on the following list, those specific ingredients must be highlighted on the label:

- gluten (a substance found in wheat, rye, barley, oats and spelt, and therefore present in foods made from these grains, such as flour)
- egg and egg products
- milk and milk products
- soya beans and products
- peanuts and products
- sesame seeds and products
- other nuts and products
- sulphites (a preservative)



Preparing food

A gentle reminder: before preparing food, please make sure that your hands, clothes, equipment and kitchen surfaces are clean, and that they remain clean throughout food preparation.

Delivery and Registration of Items

You can deliver your goodies to the St. John's cake stall area between 1pm and 3:00pm on Friday 16th November, or take them directly to the Cake Stall on Fete day from 8:45am. Health regulations require that all items must be recorded in the **registration book** when delivered, so please deliver items at the allocated times.
