Are you to the one... or must we wait?

John is now in prison and wonders about the things he hears of Jesus. John had proclaimed the reign of God was close; could it be possible that this miracle worker from Nazareth is the one Israel has been waiting for; could it be that he is the Messiah? Jesus answers John's question by pointing to his miracles as sure signs that the reign of God has arrived. Jesus then makes a contrast between the dramatic presence of John and the 'least in the kingdom'. John is praised by Jesus as the greatest of the prophets and yet for all his greatness John had not perceived the reign of God in Jesus. This is why the 'least in the kingdom' can be called greater than John. Those within the horizon of God's reign see and experience what John could only long for:

We belong to the group of those called 'the least'. We are living after the death and resurrection of Jesus and have this advantage over John. The reign of God has begun, the Spirit has been given, and we are now participants in God's reign. However, like John we can miss the miracle of God's presence. The signs are more delicate and in the busyness of our lives we may not even notice them. Advent invites us to be more perceptive, and to take time out to see the presence of God with us.
